# Have We Mentioned We Need to be Concerned for the Lost?

One Sunday, a minister began his sermon in this way: "I'd like to make three points today. First, there are millions of people around the world who are going to hell. Second, most of us sitting here today do not give a damn about it." After a lengthy pause he continued: "My third point is that you are more concerned that I, your minister, said the word damn than you are about the millions of people going to hell."

How do we overcome apathy with evangelism? We preach messages, provide continued reminders in our prayers, and we continue to have meetings here at Elizabethtown as well as encourage me to preach in other places, yet for the most part, each of us would no doubt agree we need to increase our concern for the lost.

We know God's great love for the lost. Passages like John 3:16 and Romans 5:8 clearly speak to this end. We also see passages that help to provide further information regarding the extent of God's love for the lost—God determined before He created the universe and man that He would have a plan in place to redeem mankind (Acts 2:23; Eph 1:3ff).

Scripture reveals Christ's great love for the lost. He could have called "ten thousand angels" to keep Him from the cross. He gave up the glory that He had with the Father from eternity to come to earth and take the form of a man and suffer the death of the cross (Phil 2:5ff). As Peter wrote, His great love moved Him to "bear our sin in His body on the tree (wood tree…used only twice in New Testament).

How can we ever strive to match the love of the members of the Godhead? Such a task cannot be accomplished by mere humans; surely though we can find a way to improve our acting upon our intentions (I believe all of us have full intention of going forth to preach the gospel to others). Perhaps our focus upon Deity's love for us as well as a focused effort to model our Savior may help us in our efforts to reach the lost. The Son of Man came to seek and save that which was lost...we are left with instructions to do likewise.
