Three Men Hear the Gospel Aaron Veyon

In 1 Corinthians 2 and 3 the apostle Paul mentions three types of people to whom the gospel is preached:

The gospel can cure all!

The Natural Man (2:14)

This one is exposed to the gospel of Christ – but rejects it.

The Carnal Man (3:1-4)

In this sense, this one initially receives the gospel but will not allow his conduct of life to be transformed by it.

The Spiritual Man (3:1)

This one both receives the gospel and allows his conduct of life to be transformed by it..

Three heart patients went to the doctor. The doctor warned each of them concerning their problem and gave them strict instructions to follow. The first man thought it foolish, continued in his bad health and died (cf. 1:18). The second man heeded the doctor's advice, but made no changes to correct it, and he died (cf. Lk. 8:12). The third man heeded the advice and made the necessary changes – and he lived on.

Miserable Friends Tim Dooley

I feel for Job who, when he needed comfort and compassion, got what was anything but. He rebukes his friends and goes on to express his utter feeling of abandonment and helplessness.

Are you a thoughtful and comforting friend?

As Christians we need to remember that being obedient to God and standing for the truth does not necessitate a rude, ugly, or insensitive spirit. In fact, we are to always respond with love and kindness. One can certainly rebuke another in love, discipline with compassion, and counsel with sensitivity. Peter said that as Christians we should have "compassion for one another; love as brothers," and "be tenderhearted, be courteous" (1 Peter 3:8).

Not every "friend" will be the kind of friend we need, but the Lord will! And as we will see, "Indeed we count them blessed who endure. You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end intended by the Lord—that the Lord is very compassionate and merciful" (James 5:11). Be a true friend to someone today, and be faithful!
