## Accomplished the Removal of Sins

According to 1 Peter 2:24-25, Jesus bore our sins on the cross and made it possible for us to be righteous in God's sight.

The law did not provide the complete removal of sins - Hebrews 10:1-4.

The removal of sins is one of the great features of the new covenant that Jesus established -Hebrews 8:8-13 - Hebrews 10:9-10, 14-17.
