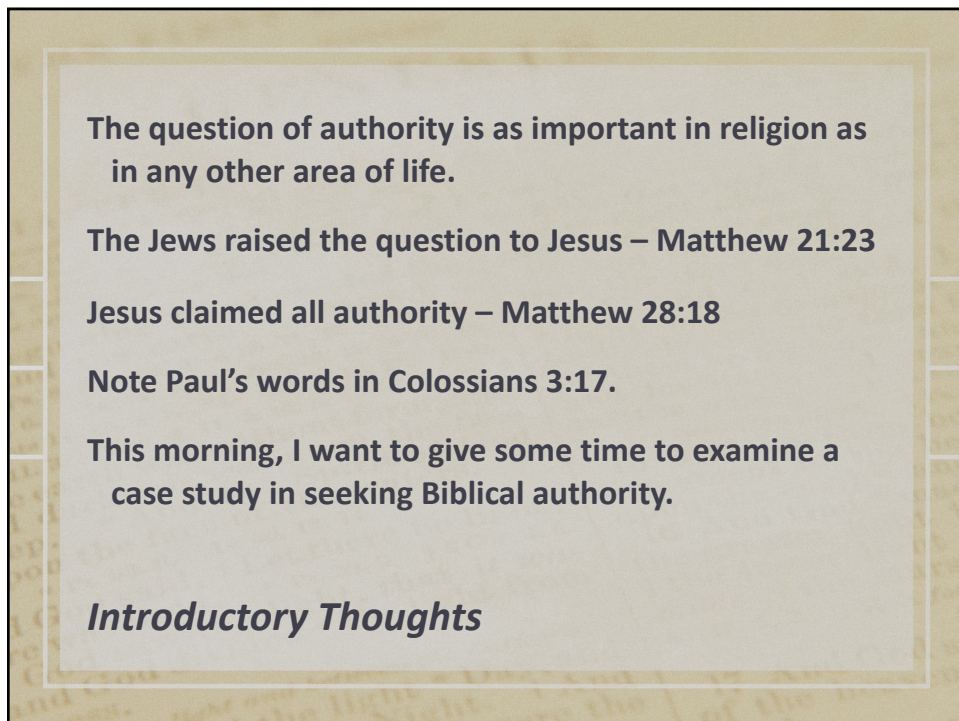

**The Story of Good King Josiah**


We begin in Exodus 20:1-4.

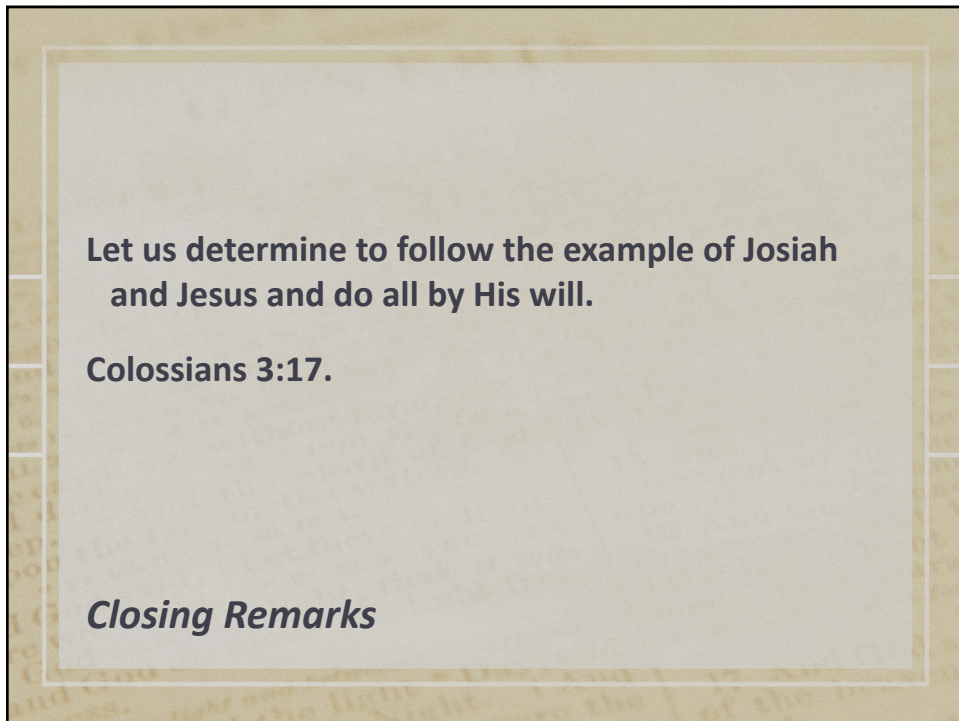
