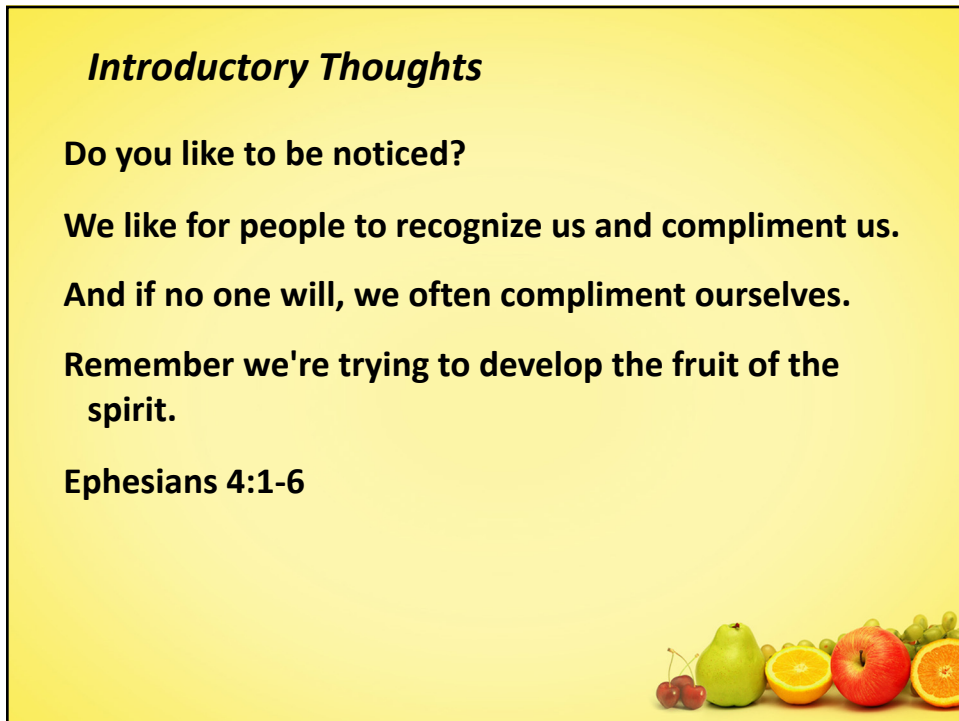

## ***Be Angry at the Right Times***

**Notice Aristotle's comment about meekness**
