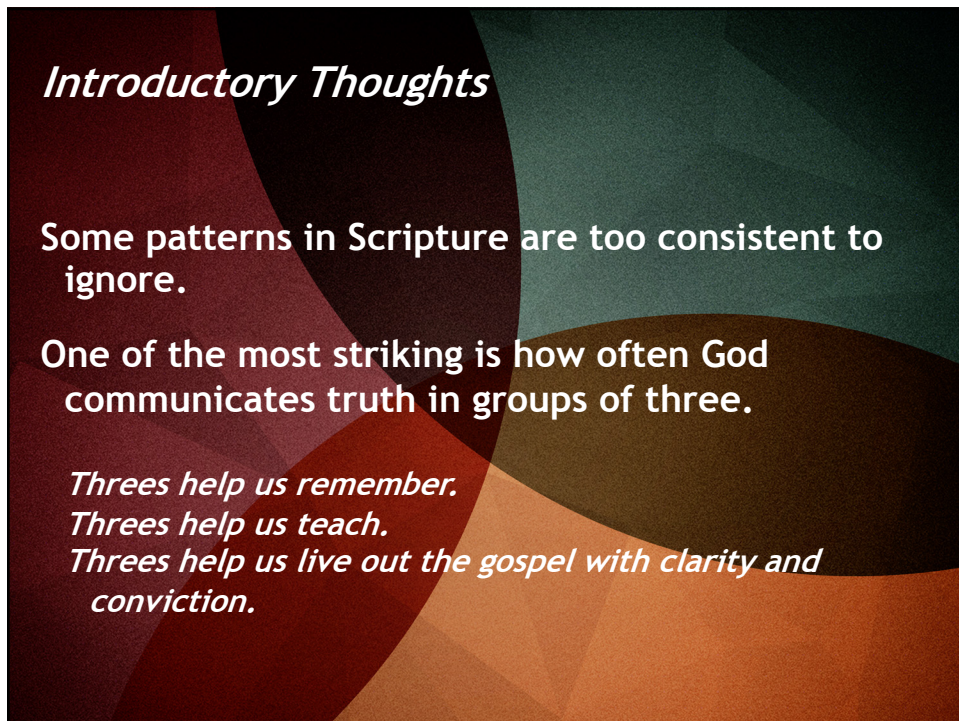




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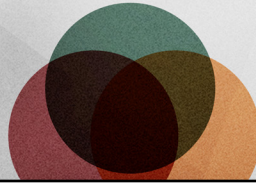
Three Divine Persons - 2 Corinthians 13:14

**God reveals Himself in a perfect, relational unity—
Father, Son, and Spirit.**

The Father – Source, Creator, Planner.

The Son – Savior, Redeemer, Mediator.

The Spirit – Helper, Sanctifier, Indweller.

Why this matters:

God is relational → we were made for relationship.

God is unified → the church must pursue unity.

God is active → each Person works in our salvation.

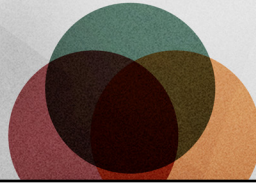

These three virtues shape the Christian life and witness.

*Faith – Trusting God’s character.
Hope – Expecting God’s promises.
Love – Reflecting God’s heart.*

Threefold Call of Discipleship - Luke 9:23

Following Jesus always involves three movements.

Deny yourself – Surrender your will.

Take up your cross – Embrace sacrifice.

Follow Me – Walk in obedience.

Threefold Call of Discipleship - Luke 9:23

Why this matters:

Discipleship is not accidental.

The cross is not optional.

Following Jesus is daily, not occasional.

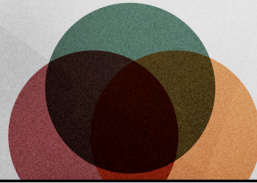

- The World – External pressure.*
- The Flesh – Internal weakness.*
- The Devil – Spiritual opposition.*
